Up to \$400 per veterinary student will be provided, and advance application must be made using the form below. Reimbursement checks will be issued after submission of the appropriate receipts (an expense reporting form will be provided for you when you are notified that your application for a travel grant has been accepted). Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis with a maximum of 4 grants awarded per school. Sufficient monies are available to fund 25 students at the \$400 level.
